Volunteer Service



The Deutsch-Indische Zusammenarbeit (Indo-German Cooperation, DIZ) has been active in the field of developmental cooperation and intercultural relations since the year 1996. The aim of the non-governmental organisation is to support projects in the field of development in the slums and the rural villages, especially in the areas of education, health, sustainable environment and the empowerment of women.

The DIZ and its Partners share the following motto: we follow an all inclusive worldview and work with people independent of their caste, creed, sex, religion, colour and background. We work together with our Indian Partners following the principle of equality. The DIZ is a charitable organisation which relies on various communities, churches and other organisations. We ensure professional interaction with our Partners and maintain personal contact regularly through several visits to our Indian Partners every year.

DIZ (Frankfurt am Main)

The volunteer will be mainly involved in developmental and educational work carried out by the DIZ in Germany. This also includes making presentations on current affairs in India as well as various topics concerning political, economic and social development of this country. The volunteer is also expected to support the DIZ Team in the various seminars organised by the DIZ for its members, volunteers, Partners and other audiences.

Gossner Mission (Berlin)

The volunteer will work in different organisations like schools, kindergartens, youth centres or senior residences. He or she is also expected to stay in the office of the Gossner Mission and support the staff-members with certain activities, e.g. maintaining the facebook-page. Besides that the volunteer should take part in different meetings and activities.
