The Indo-German Cooperation e. V. (DIZ) is a non-profit organisation that is independent of parties, churches and other organizations; it was established in 1996.

The common goal of the DIZ with its anchor partner in India, the Ecumenical Sangam Nagpur, and its other project partners is to improve the living conditions in the slums of the city of Nagpur and in the surrounding villages far from the urban infrastructure, especially in the areas of education, health, sustainable environment and empowerment of women.

What we do

1. Development cooperation

In close cooperation with our Indian partner organizations, we together plan developmental projects. We discuss these with our partner organizations and also determine the type of support (financially, personnel, etc.). Several times a year we travel to India, visit our partners, find out about project progress and discuss new projects.

2. Development education

We want to draw attention to global contexts and the need for development cooperation, to increase knowledge and to attract more people to a commitment to a more just world. We achieve this through annually changing focus topics. Target groups of our offer are private persons, pupils and in the long term also decision makers from politics and economy. In this area too, we rely on cooperation and networking with partners in Germany and Europe.

3. Volunteer services

The weltwärts developmental volunteer service aims to strengthen ties between countries of the Global North and the Global South. The intercultural exchange is facilitated through the contribution of the volunteers to social and developmental projects, either in India or in Germany.
